

Plesk Client Reference Guide

A quick map of the most useful Plesk areas for hosting customers.

Websites & Domains

- Manage domain hosting settings, document roots, redirects and subdomains.
- Open File Manager and website logs.
- Manage SSL certificates and PHP settings for the domain.

Mail

- Create mailboxes and aliases.
- Change mailbox passwords and quotas.
- Review mail-related settings available for the subscription.

Databases

- Create MySQL/MariaDB databases and users.
- Open phpMyAdmin where available.
- Import and export database data.

DNS Settings

- Manage A, AAAA, CNAME, MX and TXT records when Plesk DNS is authoritative.
- Avoid changing DNS records unless you understand which service they control.
- Keep email records intact if mail is hosted elsewhere.

Files & FTP

- Use File Manager for browser-based uploads and edits.
- Create FTP accounts when needed.
- Prefer SFTP when SSH access is available.

PHP Settings

- Select the PHP version supported by your application.
- Adjust memory, upload and execution limits only when needed.
- Test the site after every significant PHP change.
